Training Programme:

- Understanding the chemistry of fire and types of burning materials.
- different types of fire extinguishing Medias and methods of extinction and fire including practical session
- Introduction to use of fire hoses and related equipment, getting hose to work and safe branch holding and moving with charged hose line.
- Pressurized water hose training including adding a length and connecting ground monitors
- Firefighting exercises – extinguishing live fires using hoses and foam equipment

Lesson will be backed up with power point presentation.

Participants will be issued with endorsed CPD Fire team member certificates valid for three years.
